Coniferous plants

150-145 MYA



Conifers grow to over 100 metres tall and can produce male and female cones on one plant. The oldest living conifer is 9,550 years old and within their family, are the world's tallest, thickest, oldest living things.

Stegosaurus

150-145 MYA

I am a large herbivorous dinosaur with a spiked tail and large bony plates along my back.

Muttaburrasaurus

112-104 MYA

I am a herbivore and one of the largest dinosaurs ever found in Australia.

Maiasaura

100-65.5 MYA

I am a herbivorous duckbilled dinosaur and raise my young in nesting colonies.

Tyrannosaurus

67-65 MYA

I am a carnivorous dinosaur, with my powerful jaws I can eat as much as 100kg of meat in one bite.

Flowering plants

130 MYA - TODAY

Flowering plants rapidly became the most dominant type of plant. Magnolias are among the most ancient trees in existence.

Triceratops

68-65 MYA

I am a large herbivorous dinosaur with three sharp horns on my head and a bony neck frill which spanned up to 6 metres.
