

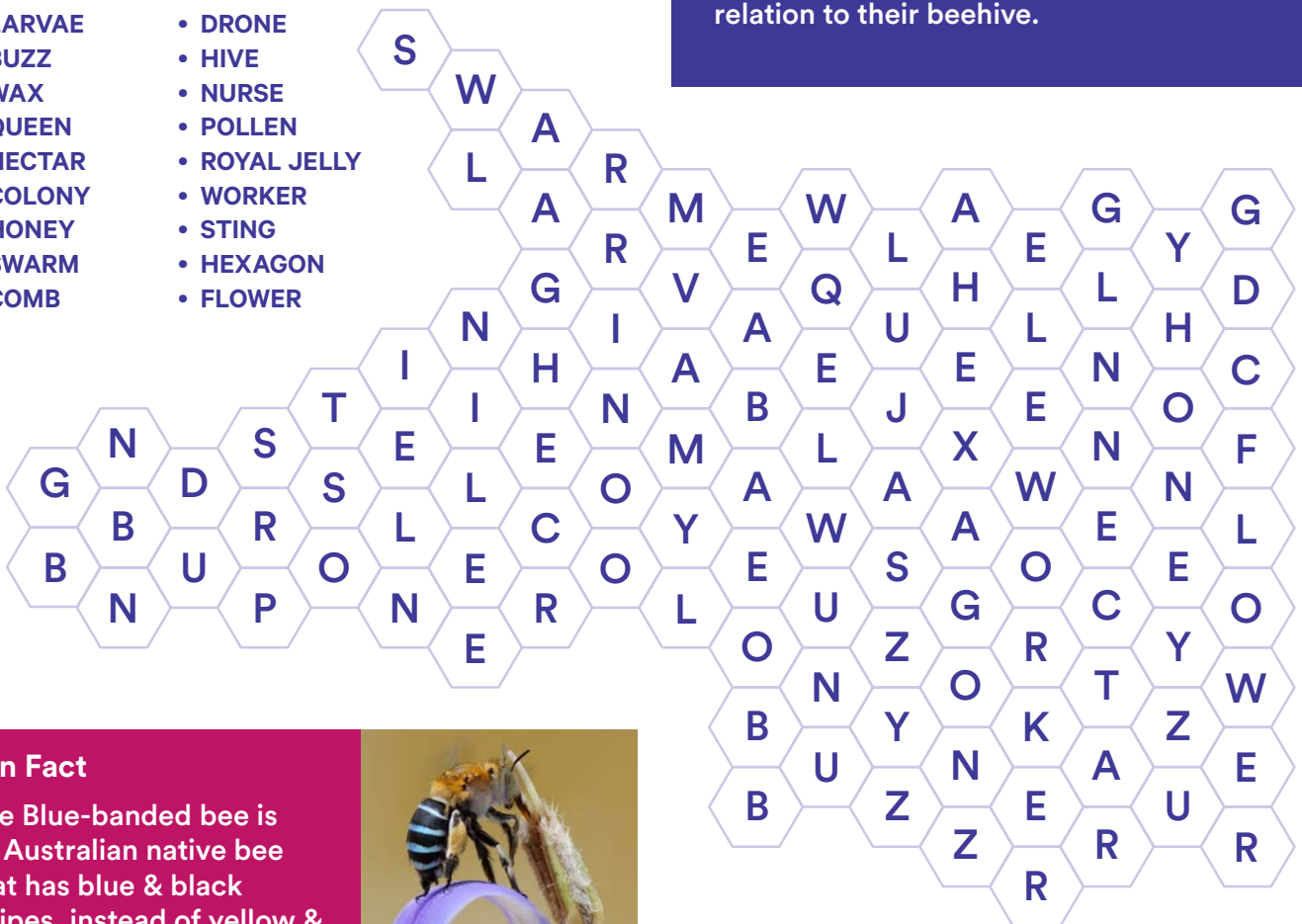
Who crowns the queen bee?
