Early Childhood Workshop

(Ages: 0-5)

This workshop provides little scientists with the opportunity to play, learn and explore at their own space. Throughout the workshop, child-parent interactions are fostered by encouraging children to ask "why?", "how?", and "what if?

Supported by the latest neuroscience research into early brain development, our Early Childhood Workshops provide a safe, exciting and interactive environment for children to engage in self-initiated play.

This unique travelling program encourages adults and young children to play, explore and discover together. The program fosters young children's natural curiosity and encourages them to ask why, how and what if?

The 60 minute workshop allows children to explore four different areas of learning: light, living things, push and pull, and sound.

LightPush and pullSound

Activities include playing with shadows and light, creating sounds, identifying smells, investigating invertebrates and more.
